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
Dear Sir,

Here are the necessary bits and bobs to test Z88's. The modified 32K RAM goes into slot 2, a 128K RAM goes into slot 1, and the test cartridge into slot 3 (obviously). Plug the 9-way into RS232 it simply feeds off \rightarrow \leftarrow so avoiding the need for external test gear.

On a hard exit on Z88 and simply follow instructions until the end of the test.

Usually if a Z88 will switch on and type, it will pass the test but it is useful for checking RS232 and validity of signals on card ports.

The test is completely useless for finding intermittent faults, (the kind you usually send to me.)
